



# HIGH POWER SHOOTING CLINIC APRIL 29 & 30 FROM CAPITAN SHOOTING RANGE

Gain from the experience of some of the top shooters in New Mexico in "Across the Course" rifle competition.

The clinic includes classroom instruction and range firing at 200, 300 & 600 yards. It is open to shooters of any age as long as you can safely handle a rifle.

In essence, a High Power Clinic is an educational event open to shooters of all ages that provides instruction on the various aspects of High Power competitive shooting. Instruction is given by NRA-qualified instructors, with the clinic culminating in a live-fire fun & informal match.

Everything a person needs to shoot competitively is available, including rifles, ammunition, scopes, and related equipment; however, it is also fine for an attendee to bring their own US Military Service Rifle and use that. As an option, you may bring any of the following rifles with ammo to use at the clinic: M-1 Garand, AR-15 / M-16, M-1A / M-14, or military bolt rifle. You will need a canvas or leather adjustable sling for your rifle. Bring 100 rounds of ammo. Armor Piercing and Tracer ammo are NOT allowed. Two magazines or stripper clips (for bolt guns) are required.

Subsequent to receiving hands-on training, the attendees are then invited to participate in an informal live-fire "mini-match" with one-on-one attention, such that each person is given the instruction needed to participate in a formal match successfully.



The course of instruction covers virtually all aspects of Competitive High-Power Shooting, including hands-on instruction in:

- The safe handling of Military-Style firearms (service rifles)

- The correct use of equipment (such as slings)

- Shooting positions

- Proper Aiming / Sight Picture

- Proper breathing,

- Handling Sight Adjustments

- Scoring Targets and "Pit" operations

- Live fire practice match on 30th
