No squadding will be issued on the firing line. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding, or who fails to be at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his privilege to compete in that event.

COMPETITORS WILL PULL TARGETS AND SCORE

SCORING: Rule 14.18a

INDENTIFICATION: NRA membership card and classification cards must be shown before any squadding will be issued.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 (assigned classification) or 19.2 (temporary classification).

RIFLES, SIGHTS AND RESTS: NRA rule, section 22 will apply

TARGETS: 1,000 yards, LRFC
